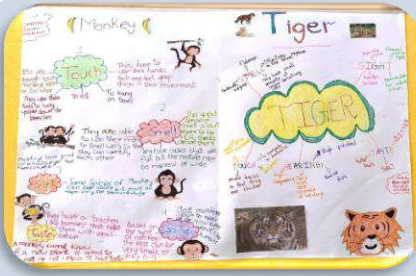
Building the Wisdom Bridge

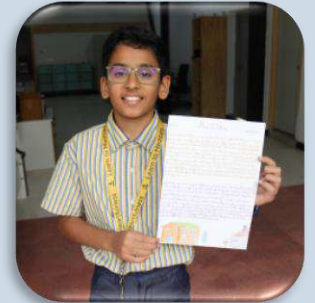
Grade 5 students elaborated their learning through mind maps, the topic was super senses of animals.

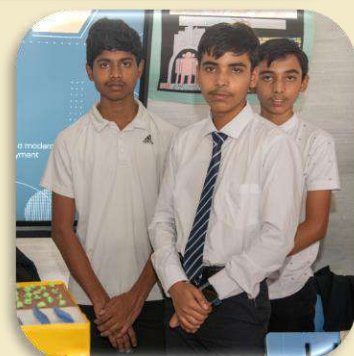
