





INTERNATIONAL PEACE DAY




International Peace Day was about the activities that students participated in. They had fun as they engaged in various team work activities and unleashed their creativity while promoting world peace.

This year, Hostlers were welcomed with an orientation ceremony followed by various enriching activities. Many special activities were arranged for the well being of the hostlers.
























Message from Leadership Team


