- 1 Papers must be submitted in A4 size, both in Word and pdf format, in single space, black ink, Calibri font size 12.
- 2 Paper title should be in Calibri font size 14 bold.
- 3 Author(s)'s name should be below the Paper title in Calibri font size 12 bold.
- 4 Author affiliation(s) to be provided below the names in Calibri font size 12.
- 5 For multiple authors, please indicate the corresponding author affiliation (s) using a footnote.
- 6 An abstract should be given in the beginning of the paper, not exceeding 200 words.
- 7 The main text of the paper should not exceed 2500 words, excluding title, abstract, figures and references.
- 8 References must be given at the end of the paper in Calibri font size 12. References are each numbered, ordered sequentially as they appear in the text. When cited in the main text, reference numbers are superscript.
